



This year, the school age immunisation service has introduced an online consent form, which is already being used to give consent for young people in year 8 receiving the HPV vaccination this year. The form can be accessed at www.leicsandrutlandimms.co.uk, and requires that parents/carers use a unique school code (which you will have been sent) alongside a contact email address.

The online form is designed to make the process easy and efficient, avoiding letters being lost, and ensuring consent is received in a timely way. The form meets all of the NHS security standards for patient information.

Please be aware when you complete the form, you need to input the school code **without any spaces or additional punctuation**. If you're having problems submitting the form, it's also a good idea to double check that when you confirm your email address, it matches the one originally submitted. <p>Seasonal Flu</p> <p>The children's flu vaccine is offered as a yearly nasal spray to young children to help protect them against flu.</p> <p>Click here ></p>	<p>Diphtheria, Tetanus & Polio (Td/IPV), Meningococcal ACWY</p> <p>The Td/IPV is given as a single jab containing vaccines against diphtheria, tetanus and polio. MenACWY vaccine is also given as a single jab containing vaccines against meningitis A, C, W and Y.</p> <p>Click here ></p>	<p>Human Papilloma Virus (HPV)</p> <p>Protects against cervical cancer, some mouth and throat cancers and some cancers of the anus and genital areas – for children under 15, two injections given 6-12 months apart.</p> <p>Click here ></p>	<p>Measles, Mumps and Rubella (MMR)</p> <p>MMR is a safe and effective combined vaccine that protects against 3 separate illnesses – measles, mumps and rubella (German measles) – in a single injection. The full course of MMR vaccination requires 2 doses.</p> <p>Click here ></p>
