



This year, the school age immunisation service has introduced an online consent form, which is already being used to give consent for young people in year 8 receiving the HPV vaccination this year. The form can be accessed at www.leicsandrutlandimms.co.uk, and requires that parents/carers use a unique school code (which you will have been sent) alongside a contact email address.

The online form is designed to make the process easy and efficient, avoiding letters being lost, and ensuring consent is received in a timely way. The form meets all of the NHS security standards for patient information.

Please be aware when you complete the form, you need to input the school code without any spaces or additional punctuation. If you're having problems submitting the form, it's also a good idea to double check that when you confirm your email address, it matches the one originally submitted.
